

red rover – service changes

As part of our ongoing service review, there are some further service changes affecting a number of our routes from 23/11/2020:

Aylesbury bus services:

- 280 The service is being reduced to operate every 30 minutes Monday – Saturday and hourly on Sundays/public holidays. However, new service 282 (below) is being introduced to keep the same overall 20-minute frequency between Aylesbury and Oxford. Some minor timetable changes, with later evening departures from Oxford on Fridays and Saturdays
- 282 NEW DAILY SERVICE between Aylesbury and Oxford, operating in conjunction with service 280. Operating hourly, in Thame the route will serve Thame Park, but does not serve Wheatley (operating direct between the M40 services and Sandhills)
- 301 This service will now only be operated by **red rover**. Earlier departures from Hemel Hempstead and later departures from Aylesbury are withdrawn
- 323 Frequency reduced to operate every 20 minutes throughout the day
- 361 Minor timing changes
- 387 **red rover** service withdrawn, with a new operator taking over
- X65 Changes to early morning timings

Aylesbury coach services (Countrywide)

- 701 Service frequency reduced to operate every four hours, daily. Combined with service 702, coaches approx. every 2 hours between Luton Airport and Heathrow Airport
- 703 Service frequency reduced to operate two daily through journeys. Combined with service 701, seven daily return journeys between Luton Airport and Aylesbury
- 415 This Countrywide service is withdrawn
